jadian enterprises is awarded contract with Dubai Municipality
Will provide software and services to the Public Health and Environmental Departments

Lansing, March 15, 2007: jadian enterprises, inc announced today that it has been awarded a contract to provide software and services to the Dubai Municipality Public Health and Environmental Departments in the United Arab Emirates. Dubai Municipality is implementing a risk-based "General Inspection and Fines Solution", based on jadian's software, designed to automate inspection and compliance processes and improve the quality of services provided to constituents. The system enables the health department to focus on high-risk, poor performing establishments through more frequent inspections, thus better focusing its resources. jadian's local partner, Intertec Systems LLC, will provide on-site project management and support.

The Dubai Municipality Public Health and Environmental Departments are responsible for protecting the overall health and well-being of Dubai's more than one million citizens. The departments engage in a wide variety of health protection activities at over 93,000 different business establishments, including food inspections, swimming pool permitting, pest control, veterinarian licensing, the monitoring of health and medical clinics, and general environmental protection (air and water quality).

"Dubai Municipality's various public health programs were using non-integrated systems that couldn't share information, which is a very common problem. The lack of integrated information was causing inefficient resource utilization and a shortage of current, actionable compliance data," said Mr. Norris. "Because Dubai is growing rapidly, an improved approach to code enforcement is critical."

Dubai Municipality's 130 inspectors will operate the bilingual software in a wireless environment using rugged handheld computers. Each inspector conducts an average of six inspections per day, which means the jadian solution will process almost 800 inspections per day or 175,000 annually. "One of the main goals is to ensure that all Dubai facilities are being inspected properly and are in compliance with Dubai health codes," said Mr. Norris. "Our solution will enable the Health Department to standardize the inspection process across all the different public health programs, collect inspection data electronically, and analyze the data for trends."
