Lansing Software Company Plays Role in United Arab Emirates Worker's Rights Effort

jadian's software has been selected to provide the technology infrastructure for the Ministry of Labor's newly formed Inspection Authority

Lansing, February 14, 2007: Inspection and compliance software created by jadian enterprises, inc is playing a role in the current effort to improve working conditions in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). The UAE Ministry Of Labor selected jadian's software as the technology backbone for its Inspection Authority, which is responsible for enforcing the country's labor laws.

Explosive growth in the UAE has created employment opportunities for over 2.7 million migrant workers, but their treatment has garnered harsh criticism from the international community. The Human Rights Watch characterizes the situation as one of wage exploitation, dangerous working conditions, and lack of enforcement on behalf of the federal government. In response, UAE Minister of Labor Dr. Ali Bin Abdulla Al Kaabi promised major investment in the personnel and technologies required to inspect business practices and issue stiff fines for violations of UAE labor laws.

jadian's software will be used to manage the day-to-day activities of the Ministry's Labor Inspection Authority. Inspectors will download inspection schedules to handheld computers, conduct inspections, print on-site reports, and issue immediate fines. The system will also handle requests for visa inspections, investigation of late or non-existent salary payments,

expired labor cards, and other labor-related issues. The current pilot test involves just over 100 labor inspectors, with that number expected to surpass 1,000 within the next eighteen months. The Inspection Authority oversees more than 240,000 businesses within the United Arab Emirates.

“We are proud that our software can contribute to such an important social issue,” said Mr. Norris, President and CEO of jadian enterprises. “When I met with the Minister of Labor, he expressed his commitment to correcting the labor situation and has been taking action to do so. Our system enables UAE inspectors to focus on high-risk, repeat violators and hopefully improve overall working conditions in that country.”
